Services for Seniors

‘Better at Home’ provides services, or referrals to services, to seniors 65 years of age or older living independently in Dawson Creek who face barriers to performing these tasks on their own.

- House Cleaning
- Friendly Visits
- Home Maintenance/Handyman
- Transportation/Accompaniment
- Snow Removal
- Yard Work

Cost

Most services are provided free by local volunteers. If a contractor must be hired, seniors may be required to pay a portion of the cost depending on their income.

Volunteers

Volunteers have control over their schedules and the types of services they provide;

- Social visits or taking seniors shopping or to appointments.
- Mowing lawns or shoveling snow
- Odd jobs - like moving furniture or hanging curtains.
- Helping out at special events or with fundraising.

No matter what you like to do or how much time you can spare, there’s a volunteer opportunity for you!

We also offer specialized training opportunities and will send you our monthly newsletter.

Sustainability

We direct volunteer efforts as much as possible to meet needs. We actively seek additional sources of financing and organize fundraising events to help us meet our mandate.
