

Rhubarb Cake

Ingredients - Cake

- * 1 egg, beaten
- * 1¼ cup sugar
- * 1 tsp baking soda
- * ½ tsp salt
- * 1 cups flour
- * 2½ cups fresh rhubarb, chopped small
- * 1 cup sour cream

Ingredients - Topping

- * 1 cup brown sugar
- * ¼ cup flour
- * ¼ cup margarine

Garnish

- * Cinnamon



Instructions:

- ◇ Preheat oven to 350°.
- ◇ Grease a 9 x 13 inch pan.
- ◇ Mix cake ingredients together and pour into pan.
- ◇ Mix all topping ingredients together and sprinkle on batter.
- ◇ Sprinkle liberally with cinnamon. Bake for 45 minutes.
